

Full uniform (without belt) is to be worn when travelling from UK & on return to UK.
Please ensure scarves have been ironed.

Hold Luggage (your main ruck sack)

The appropriate quantities of:-

Socks and underwear

Shorts

Trainers and/or casual shoes

Tracksuit or cotton type trousers

(Scout trousers are ideal)

A warm hat (Jeff confirms you will need it)

Personal medicines/medical

Walking socks

A $\frac{1}{2}$ litre water bottle (this will be provided)

A sleeping bag (which packs small to fit inside your rucksack)

A torch and spare batteries (take the batteries out of the torch when travelling)

Camera batteries/charger, if camera taken

DK logo'd Garments (Polo Shirt(s), T-Shirt(s), Hoody(s)/Sweatshirt(s))

Some polythene bags would be a good idea to separate clean and dirty items.

Night Wear

Wash kit, towel, etc

Warm top/fleece

T-shirts and/or long sleeved shirts

Sun-block

A sun hat (see group identity below)

Personal reading material

Swim wear

Hand Luggage - this is your "Day ruck sack"

Medicines (including any inhaler/epi-pen)

1 x contingent sweatshirt

A warm waterproof jacket

A notebook and pencil

Scout belt/buckle

Sun glasses

1 x contingent hat

Sandwiches

Camera - optional

Other

Walking boots or stout shoes (To save baggage weight you should wear your walking boots on the journey to and from Denmark)

Group Identity

You will be travelling to and from Denmark in full scout uniform, which will include the DK08 Neckerchief, Uniform shirt, Scout trousers.

Scouts/explorers scouts flying Ryanair will be loaned a large (blue) backpack which should be packed to weigh no more than 15Kg. This bag will be going in the aeroplane hold. Your hand luggage should be in a "day rucksack" and should comply with the Ryan Air requirements detailed on the other side of this sheet.

ALL items of personal property should be name labelled with an indelible pen, **especially on contingent items** - there will be very many of us wearing the same type of kit!

CABIN BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Each passenger (excluding infants) is permitted to carry one piece of cabin baggage on board (free of charge). It should weigh no more than 10kg and not exceed the maximum dimensions of 55cm x 40cm x 20cm. Due to security restrictions - certain items cannot be carried in cabin baggage - [click here for details](#). For the safety and convenience of all passengers, cabin baggage must fit underneath the seat or in the overhead compartment.
