You will be working in teams in a practical (outdoor) leader supervised activity.

Clothing/uniform:

Activity wear (not uniform), is recommended for the practical part of the afternoon. Do bring wet weather gear in case the weather is not brilliant. Please bring uniform tops & scarves to change into for the info session with parents and leaders at 5pm and for the group photos to be taken to promote the event.

Food

You should have a good lunch before coming to the event - only drinks & biscuits/cakes will be provided at the event.

Medical related

Parents please **let me** know in advance (or on arrival at the event) of any current/ongoing medical issues/allergies your son/daughter may have & any medication being taken. Written information preferred, to avoid confusion. Inhalers (if used) should be brought to the event.

Information meeting for parents (& contingent members) at 5 p.m.

Parents are asked to come along for 5pm:

- to meet the adult team;
- so we can provide both you and your son/daughter with an update of the planning so far ;
- so we can obtain direct from you any other essential information we need at this stage ;
- so we may hear any concerns you have at this stage to enable us to address them in good time.

We aim to be away by 6pm (approximately) - we do hope you will be able to come along in person.

The Venue & Parking

Littleport Scout Centre is in the grounds of Littleport Leisure Centre, Camel Road, Littleport CB6 1PU (for those with SatNavs) – the following link shows the location on a map:
