



PARENTAL PERMISSION and DECLARATION FORM

WATER ACTIVITIES

Because Canoeing is an Adventurous Activity it is necessary that all participants have received their Parents permission. Unfortunately failure to do so will mean NO CANOEING.

AIR RIFLE COMPETITION

Under Scout Association Rules specific permission is needed by a Parent or Guardian before a Young Person may take part in a Shooting Activity.

No signed permission no Activity

Section 21 of the Firearms Act (1968) prohibits the possession or handling of a firearm (including Airguns) and ammunition (under any circumstances), by any person who has been convicted of a crime and sentenced to a term of imprisonment (or its equivalent for a young person) of 3 months or more.

A sentence of :-

- Less than 3 months there is no prohibition
- 3 months to 3 years attracts a 5 year prohibition to handling a firearm.
- More than 3 years means a life ban, to handling a firearm.

- He/she can swim 50m in light clothing and tread water for 5 minutes. Disability or being unable to swim does not exclude youngsters. Discuss the matter with your Leader, who will inform the organisers.
