Claustrophobia and fear of the dark	Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Emergency Escape doors with 'glow in the dark' signs are built into the outside walls at intervals The roof is removable quickly to access anyone who is distressed P Participants can carry and use their own torches. 	
Stuck in a 'gate'	Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A gauge of the smallest gate is used to check the participant is not too large to traverse the 'cave' The roof is removable quickly to access anyone who is stuck in a gate. 	
Roof guy lines and pegs	Participants and pedestrians circling the 'cave'	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Guys are white elastic bungee for good visibility Pegs are bright yellow Participants and pedestrians are discouraged or prevented from traversing around the 'cave' 	
Splinters	Constructors and Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All constructors to wear work gloves. All edges are checked on assembly, dismantling and regularly during the operation to ensure smooth gates.
