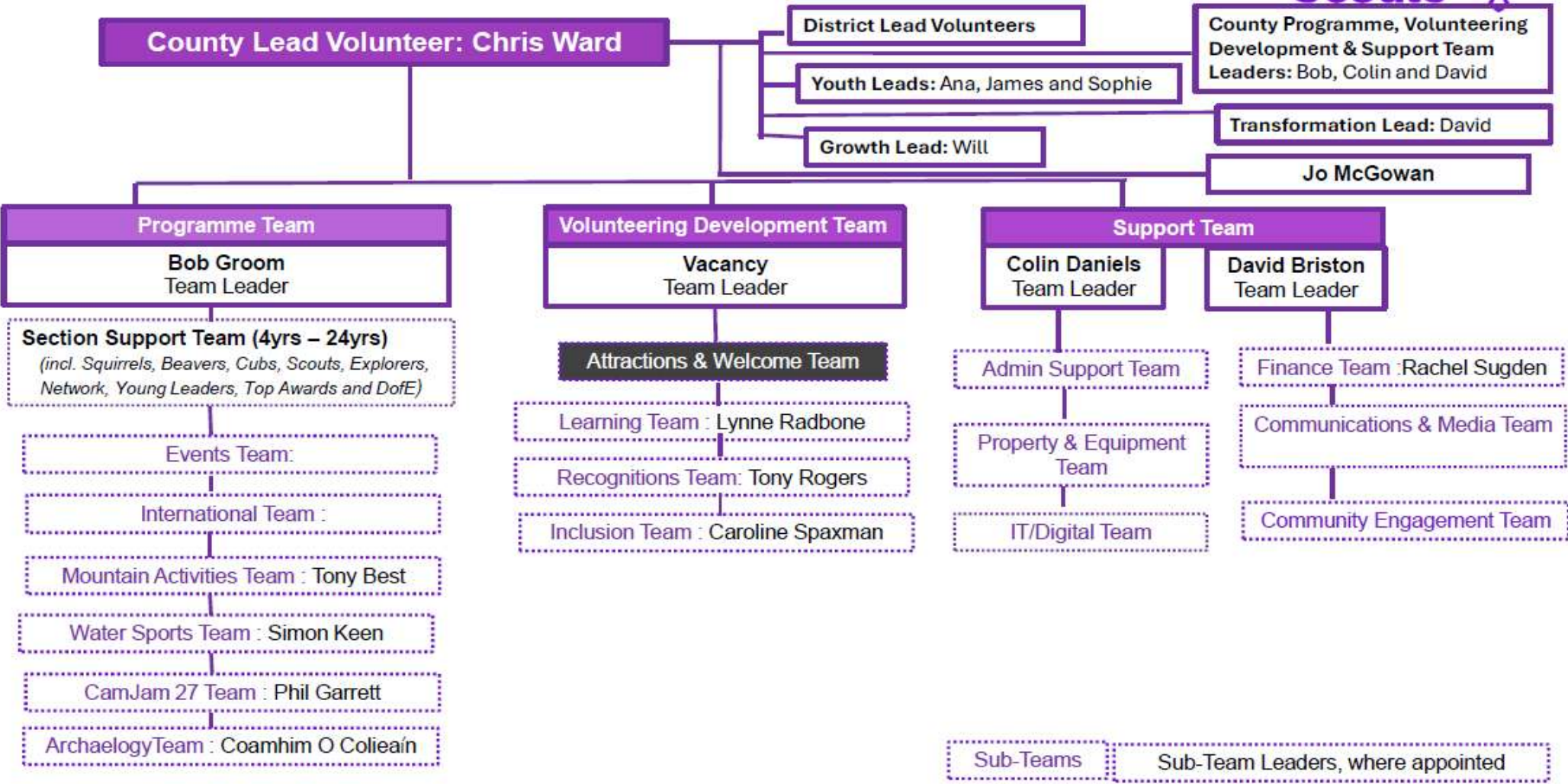

- Increase opportunities for young people to take part in Scouting by recruiting a County Growth & Development Officer. Build Growth capability / Adult recruitment plus specific project approach

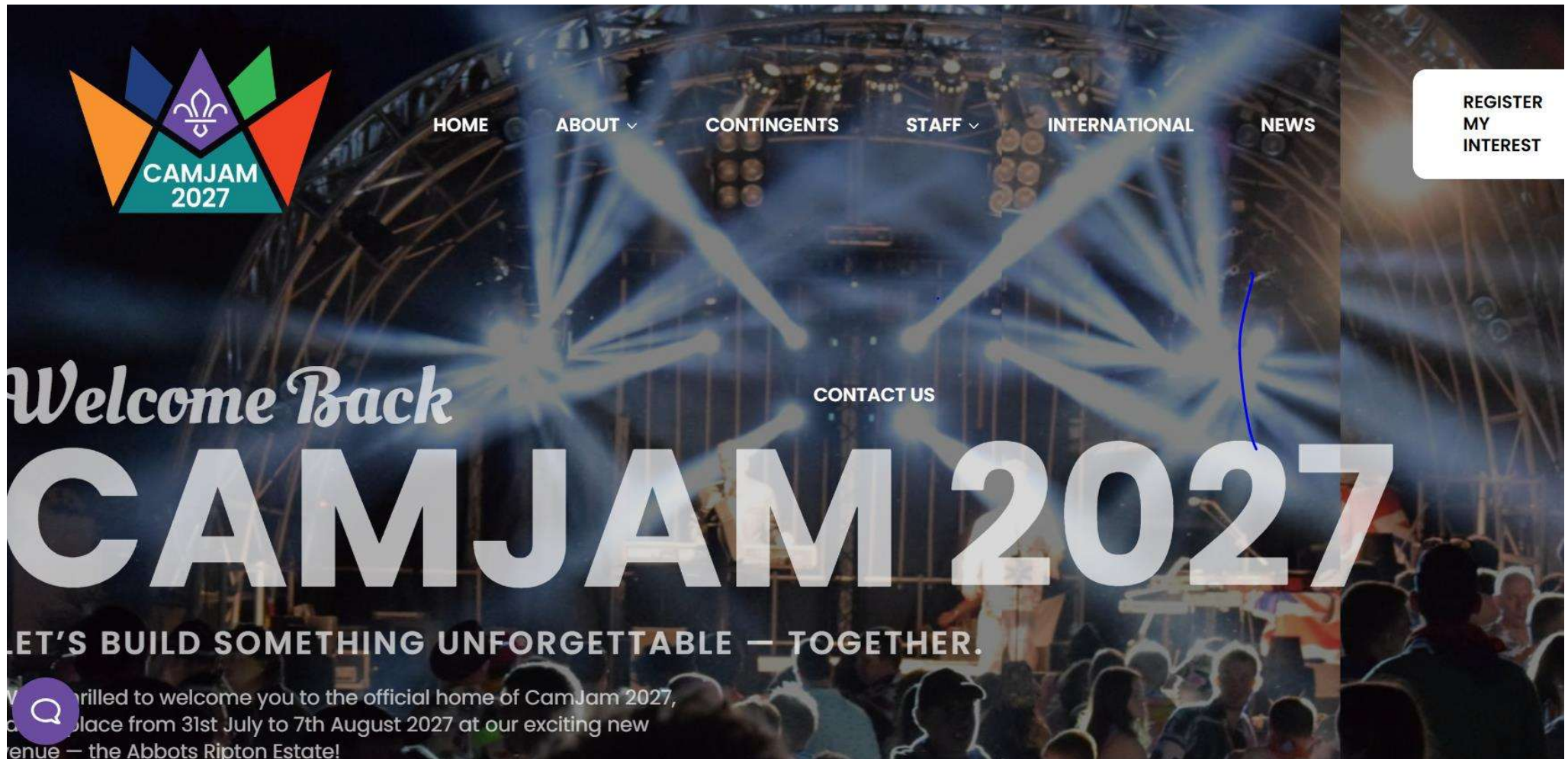

Discretionary and Hardship funds

- There are two separate funds at County level that can be used on a discretionary basis. Up to £5,000 from each fund is made available across the County and topped up each year depending on how it has been utilised.
- **Discretionary Fund** covers requests from Members (young people and adults) that support the aims of the movement.
- **Hardship Fund** covers specific hardship situations from Members (young people and adults).
- Discretionary Fund and Hardship Fund requests of up to £250 can be approved immediately on consideration by Chris as County Lead Volunteer.
- Funding requests, be they Discretionary or Hardship, that exceed £250 may be considered, based on situation and circumstances, and are subject to approval by the County Finance Team.
- That's up to 40 Discretionary and Hardship awards of £250 each year.
- How to claim? Make a case in writing to Chris, County Lead Volunteer.
